It should be placed as close to the kitchen canopy as possible to reduce grease build up in the downstream ductwork. Direction of air flow (right to left; left to right) is to be specified on ordering

Maintenance

A Plasma Clean service contract is available (please enquire) and in any case Plasma Clean would recommend:

- Servicing is normally confined to the regular cleaning of the filter components (steam or degreasing fluid).
- The aluminium prefilters require washing when dirty
- Cleaning of the ionisers and collector cells should be carried out on a regular basis
- For maximum efficiency establish a regular cleaning cycle based on routine checks of the ionisers and collector cells during the first few months of use.
